COOKIE DESCRIPTION

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device by websites and services that you visit or access. They are widely used to make websites and services function efficiently, and to inform us about our users' experience interacting with our Site, Application, or Product, and advertisements. Some cookies last only during a web session and expire when you exit the browser; other cookies may last longer than your web session. For example, some cookies may be placed and remain on your device after you exit your browser to recognize you when you return to our website. 	rely on for fraud prevention. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work.					
Performance Cookies	These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, such as which pages are visited most often and if users receive error messages from web pages. These cookies do not collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. They are used solely to improve the performance of the website and understand user interactions.					
Targeting Cookies	We use third party service providers to display advertising on our Services and serve advertising on other third party sites that may be relevant to you or your interests. These cookies are also used to help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They remember that you have visited a website and this information may be shared with other organizations, such as advertisers. This means that after you have been to our websites, you may see some advertisements about our Services elsewhere on the Internet. The information collected through this process by the third party service providers does not enable us or them to identify your name, contact details or other personal information that directly identifies you unless you choose to provide these. Such advertising will only be delivered where permitted by applicable law. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less advertising tailored to your inferred interests on our Website and will not receive targeted advertisements on third party websites.					
Functional Cookies	These cookies are used to enhance the performance and functionality of the Website but are not essential for its operation. These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make (such as your username, language, or the region you are in) and provide more personal features. They can also be used to provide services you have asked for, such as watching a video or commenting on a blog. The information these cookies collect may be

HOW LONG COOKIE STAY ON BROWSING DEVICE

Persistent cookies are set to automatically expire after a defined duration (for example, a few days, weeks or months).
